David's journey is a testament to the transformative power of support, passion, and perseverance. Growing up shy and struggling to connect with peers, he found solace and purpose in the world of performing arts, thanks to two compassionate teachers who recognised his potential. Their encouragement opened the door to the school drama club, where David discovered a newfound love for singing and acting.

At 17, David secured his first professional contract, which marked the beginning of a vibrant career in theatre, cabaret, and touring shows across the UK. The thrill of performing reached new heights when he joined the 90s pop and Eurovision supergroup SCOOCH, signed by EMI Records, who went on to represent the UK in the Eurovision Song Contest in 2007.

In 2000, the millennium dawned and David returned to his North East roots with a vision to give back. He launched Performers' Stage School, a trailblazer in the performing arts. For 22 years, the school shone as a beacon of inspiration, fostering the dreams of countless aspiring artists and proving that with the right support, anything is possible. David's journey reflects not only personal achievement but also a commitment to uplifting others in their pursuit of the arts.



FOUNDER & MANAGING DIRECTOR

Liam has dedicated the past 17 years to the theatrical industry. In his early years, he performed on stage but soon discovered his true passion lay in production, leading him to step away from his jazz shoes and embrace the creative world of theatre.

In 2012, Liam founded Astravaganza Entertainment with the goal of staging professional-level productions for North East talent to shine. To date, he has produced over 20 full-scale musicals, plays, and concerts, taking pride in the fact that his work has been showcased at nearly every professional theatre in the North East, including Northern Pride.

As a freelance Company Manager, Liam has worked on major productions such as Evita in the West End, UK Tours of The Sound of Music, and Dirty Dancing, along with Grease in Dubai and Thoroughly Modern Millie in Canada. He has also managed five pantomimes at the Theatre Royal Newcastle.

In 2024, Liam made a decision to anchor himself in the North East and concentrate on his North East production companies. He serves as the UK Promoter for the international Cabaret Drag Show, Deja Vu.

Liam thrives on a challenge and last year was his most ambitious year to date, staging three major musicals and a Festive Concert back to back, followed by a nine-date UK Tour with his North East Adult Pantomime Company, entertaining 17,500 people from Clapham Grand to the Nottingham Arena. Liam has no signs of slowing down and is thrilled to announce the opening of the Astravaganza Academy, a new division of the beloved Astravaganza brand.


ASTRAVAGANZA ALLSTARS
